Key Statistics

Children and youth

 **3,782** children found friendship, support and physical activity at YMCA child care programs.

 **3,738** Youth Action participants accessed our Community Initiatives at their local Y, at their school, or in their neighbourhood.


 **2,893** children participated in YMCA Day Camp programs aimed at encouraging independence, skill development and physical activity.


Employment and Immigrant Services

 More than **2,939** newcomers and their families were connected with a wide range of vital community resources as they find their path in Canada.

 A total of **9,051** individuals accessed YMCA Employment and Immigrant Services programs or resources.


We reached beyond our walls to bring YMCA health programs outside to local parks and community gathering places.

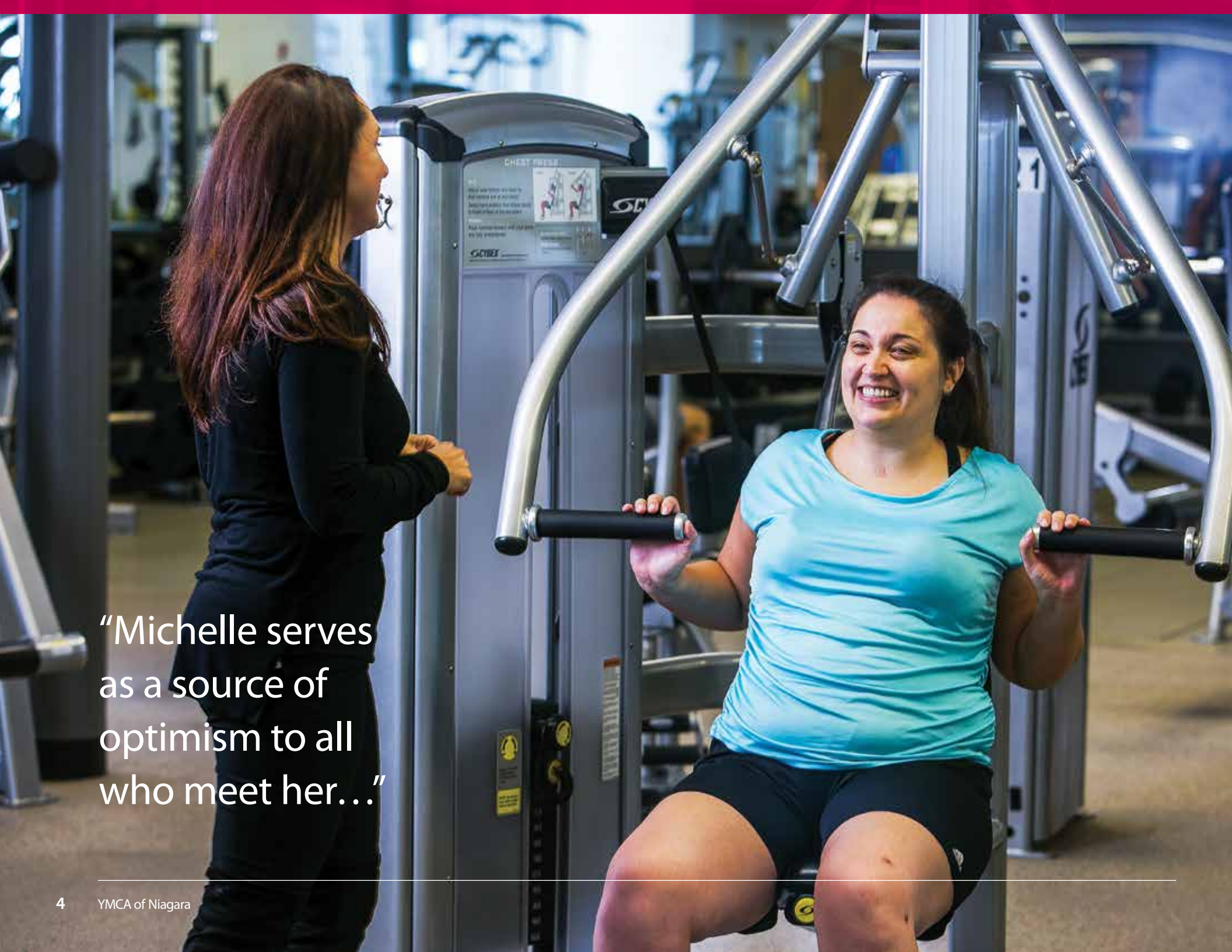

Michelle Paliniewicz

Michelle Paliniewicz is a daughter, a sister, a friend, an athlete and above all else, a fighter. In 2011 Michelle was destined for success, having amassed a long list of athletic and academic achievements, including her recent graduation from teacher's college. Michelle was on her way to securing a promising career as a teacher in an Oakville private school until the unexpected happened. Michelle suffered a major heart attack which resulted in a serious brain injury.

Michelle was placed in an induced coma for six weeks. She was diagnosed with an anoxic brain injury; a condition associated with the absence of vital signs.

Following months of intensive therapy, Michelle was discharged from hospital. Now confined to a wheelchair, Michelle experienced sensory deficits, a severe decline in motor skills, mental stamina and processing speed.

Diane, Michelle's mother, was concerned that progress from intensive therapy could be lost without continued physical activity and muscle stimulation. This led Diane and Michelle to the Niagara West YMCA in Grimsby. Little did either know the profound impact this decision would have on Michelle's recovery.

Michelle would be paired with Shelby, a Fitness Team Member who would become greatly invested in her recovery process. Michelle came into the Y in a fragile mental and emotional state, but Shelby recognized her fighting spirit and unparalleled strength. The two would work closely together developing a deep bond and friendship.

“The impact of Michelle's determination and progress has been felt and celebrated throughout our YMCA community. The personal strides Michelle has made are countless, her improvement extraordinary. She is a different person than the Michelle who came into the Niagara West Y in 2012, and because of her, so am I,” says Shelby. “Michelle serves as a source of optimism to all who meet her and I will forever be thankful to both Diane and Michelle for giving

me a renewed purpose and helping me to redefine what is really important to live a life of fulfillment.”

A defining moment in Michelle's recovery was the use of stairs at the Niagara West YMCA. A profoundly difficult challenge, Michelle progressed from climbing just a single stair to climb the entire stair case. The first time Michelle climbed the entire stair case, YMCA staff and fellow members were there to meet her and erupted into applause and cheers showing their admiration of Michelle's determination and fortitude.

“You never know what might happen tomorrow. No one can ever really be prepared for the things life throws at them,” says Michelle's mom Diane. “Though Michelle's world has changed forever, she

will always be our daughter, sister, friend, teacher and a natural athlete. Shelby and the staff at the Y always help to remind us of that. Michelle and I, along with our family are grateful that Shelby came into our lives and that we have become a part of the YMCA family.”

Grealy Family

Jim and Heather Grealy know from experience that finding time to stay healthy and active can be challenging for a busy family. As parents to Fintan (15), Braden (12), Nolan (9), Eva (7) and Ellie (7), they struggled to find a place where all of their family could participate in health and fitness activities that appealed to each of them. Then they found the YMCA.

With different programs for each of their children such as swimming lessons, karate, and YMCA Kid Fit, the Grealy family takes advantage of the full menu of programs at the Niagara Falls YMCA.

As they've raised their family, the YMCA's become a home away from home.

"The YMCA enables us to connect as a family. We love the fact there is something for everyone here. Fintan thoroughly enjoys the pool and the great lifeguarding staff, Braden is always thrilled to go to karate, Nolan loves the games in the gym, Eva and Ellie have a blast doing DrumFit, while Jim and I just love having a place to go that the whole family can enjoy," says Heather.


For many parents, juggling work and family can mean personal health gets neglected. For Jim and Heather, attending the YMCA on a regular basis helps the two maintain a balanced and healthy lifestyle while providing the children a place to meet new friends, have fun and develop their own healthy lifestyle habits.

Mike Cross

Mike Cross is no stranger to adversity. His parents divorce at age of seven, was just the beginning of a series of personal challenges he would face during his young life.

Soon after, Mike, his half-sister and mother would move into co-operative housing.

His mother struggled to provide the care and support her children needed as she faced her own personal battle with drug addiction. Mike and his half-sister frequently found themselves alone.

Eventually, Mike’s half-sister, the one consistent source of support and stability in his life during this difficult period, made the difficult decision to move out and in with her own father.

At nine years of age, Mike felt alone and overwhelmed with fear and uncertainty.

In the years that followed, Mike faced continued volatility at home. He moved through a series of different homes. When he eventually moved in with his father, he quickly learned he was not welcome and had to leave there as well.

It was at the Walker Family YMCA that Mike always felt welcome. The Y was a place where he could spend time afterschool and on weekends working out with friends.

Despite his personal challenges, Mike remained determined to succeed.

At the age of 15, he was selected as 1 of 60 recipients across Canada to receive a CIBC scholarship. This scholarship would help Mike pay his way through post-secondary education and provide him with a paid internship. Familiar with the Walker Family YMCA in St. Catharines, Mike jumped at the chance to become part of the staff.

“During the difficult times in my life, the Y was one place I felt welcome and safe. I knew the YMCA was a place for families, for kids and for teenagers like me who need positive role models and a safe space to spend free time. Working at the Walker Family YMCA helped me feel like I was a welcome part of a team, and made me realize I wanted to pursue a career in health and fitness.”

Today, Mike is currently completing his third year of study in Health and Fitness at Niagara College. He plans to attend Brock University to further his education and secure a degree in Kinesiology. Mike aspires to continue his career at the YMCA in fitness.

“I came to understand the importance that strong role models play in building a healthy life. At the YMCA, part of my job is to be a strong role model. It is also my job to ensure everyone who comes into the Y feels welcome. I know how important that was for me as a struggling teenager. Every day I come to a job that I love and I know that I am heading into a career that will help people live a healthy balanced life.”

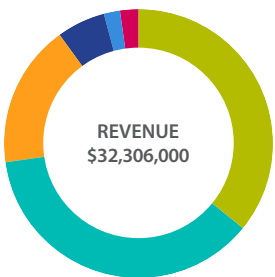

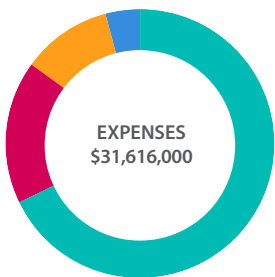
