Children can enjoy being a kid, feel safe and included, develop positive relationships, and celebrate their uniqueness. Adventure Club staff have a passion for supporting and developing resiliency in children who need it the most.

Group Leaders are responsible for the safety, supervision, and care of a group of children. They will lead a variety of exciting activities for the children in their group throughout the day, and ensure they have an amazing program experience.

- Experience working or volunteering with children or youth
- Values driven individuals who make excellent role models for children and youth
- Experience working in day or residential camp is an asset
- Energy, enthusiasm and flexibility
- Current Standard First Aid with CPR-C
