- Submit monthly regional subsidy trackers, QCCN, Immunization reports, and Health and Safety reports.
- Ensure that the centre meets or surpasses all YMCA Playing to Learn standards.
- Ensure that the centre meets or surpasses all Ministry of Education licensing standards.
- Represent the YMCA in a positive and professional manner.
- Participate in training and adhere to the YMCA Child Protection Policies and Procedures as established by the YMCA of Niagara.
- Provide leadership to the Stronger Together Campaign.
- Other duties as required.

QUALIFICATIONS

- RECE or equivalent post secondary education.
- Minimum of 2 years licensed child care experience (regulation 137/15).
- Current immunizations as required by Niagara Regional Public Health and the Ministry of Education.
- YMCA Playing to Learn training an asset.
- Food Handlers certification.
- Current Standard First Aid, CPR-C certification.
- Upon hiring, a clear and satisfactory criminal reference check inclusive of the vulnerable sector search (CRC VSS) issued for the YMCA of Niagara.
