General Camp Info

Picking the Right Camp

Before you register for YMCA Day Camps, make sure you are selecting the most suitable camp for your child. Here are some helpful hints to guide you in picking the right camps.

Select camps with your child that match their interests and meet your needs. Note the location and description of each camp you choose.

Consider how many weeks your child will attend and if they'd benefit from a variety of camps or prefer consistent routines and familiar faces.

At our outdoor sites activities run rain or shine. Campers should dress for the weather and will have access to a pavilion or shelter. Outdoor washrooms and handwashing stations are provided.

Registration Reminders

YMCA Day Camp registrations must be completed online at ymcaofniagara.org

Credit, debit, or pre-paid card (AMEX, Visa, or Mastercard) information is required at the time of registration. Payment via Electronic Funds Transfer is also acceptable (Enter your chequing account information). Camp can be set up to be paid on June 5, or split payment options are available.

Registrations received on or after June 5, 2026 must be paid in full.

Limited spaces are available and are assigned on a first-come-first-served basis. If the camp is full, please add your child(ren) to the waiting list, and we will contact you if a space becomes available.

Cancellation Policy

All refund requests must be emailed to the day camp office at ymcadaycamp@niagara.ymca.ca

Full refunds will be issued if requested prior to June 5, 2026. Requests on or after June 5, 2026 will incur a \$25 processing fee per camper. Camp fees are non-refundable within 10 days of the camp.

Refunds will not be issued if a camper is absent, sent home as a result of their behaviour, if they are ill, or if they are directed to isolate/stay home.

In order to provide a quality camp program and experience, a session may be cancelled by the YMCA due to low registrations. Campers will be offered an alternative camp location or refund.

Day Camp locations are subject to change based on site availability with our community partners.

Ages for Camp

Camps are available for children aged 5-12, with select camps offered for youth aged 13-14. Availability may vary per location and program offerings. You must register your child at a camp with the appropriate age group.

Children must meet the age requirements for their selected camp by the first day of the camp.

Helping Hands

Does your child require support in camp? Our Helping Hands program offers 1:1 support for children with physical, and/or developmental disabilities, mental health, or behavioural considerations so they can enjoy a positive and supportive camp experience alongside their peers. From bold acrylic paintings to soft watercolour blends, from clay creations to oil pastel magic—plus sketching, colouring, and more—artists will dive into a mix of our absolute favourite mediums. It's the ultimate art adventure for curious creators who love to try it all!

Weeks 5, 9: Wild at the Zoo - Roar into a week of animal-inspired art! Artists will explore fun techniques with acrylics and watercolours, try new styles, and build confidence with every brushstroke. To wrap it all up, each artist will dream up and paint their very own masterpiece on canvas—ready to hang and show off!

Weeks 4, 8: SMASH Art - Get ready to mix it, squish it, paint it, and create it! SMASH Art Week is all about trying a little bit of everything. Weeks 1, 4: Little Doc | Medical Marvels

Our youngest future doctors will use a real stethoscope and other medical instruments to role-play the key responsibilities of a doctor. They will explore key organs and systems of the body, practice scrubbing, and suturing like a real surgeon and make models of the brain and spine!

Weeks, 2, 9: Little Vet | Feline Friends

Campers will role-play the key responsibilities of a veterinarian and perform a whiskers-to-tail exam on their newly adopted plush cat! These future veterinarians will learn about animal body language, maintain a healthy environment such as proper litterbox placement, create a cat toy, and design a vet clinic.

Weeks 3, 5, 7: Marine Biology | Sea Turtle Rescue

Dive into the deep ocean with us! This program offers campers a dynamic, hands-on introduction to marine biology. Participants will conduct ocean experiments, adopt a plush sea turtle, and partake in a collaborative sea turtle rescue. Along their journey they will uncover the mysteries of ocean layers, vertebrates vs. invertebrates, ocean animal babies, and more!

Week 8: Little Vet | Pawesome Adventures

Camp participants will role-play the key responsibilities of a veterinarian and learn how to care for their very own plush puppy! These future veterinarians will learn how to remove ticks, perform a nose-to-tail exam, understand proper animal nutrition and hydration, suture lacerations, and more.

Week 9: Forensic Science | STEM Sleuths

Uncover clues and crack the case with Little Medical School. This hands-on summer camp immerses students in forensic science through activities like fingerprinting, crime scene security, age progression, and sensory sharpening exercises. They'll experiment with toxicology, handwriting analysis, and composite drawings.

Weeks 3, 5, 7: Marine Biology | Whale Tale

Dive into the underwater world of Marine Biology and learn all about whales! Campers will conduct ocean experiments, adopt a plush orca, and uncover the mysteries of the ocean layers. They will learn about ocean mammals, water pressure, ocean predators, and more!

Week 1, 4: Little Doc | Future Physicians

Thinking about a career in medicine? At our Little Doctor camp, participants will role-play the key responsibilities of a doctor and learn about vital organs in the human body. These future physicians will learn how to use a stethoscope, blood pressure cuff, and reflex hammer. They will practice suturing, administering first aid, and learn how pharmacists administer medications.

Week 8: Wilderness Medicine | Conquer the Great Outdoors

Get ready to conquer the great outdoors! Campers will manage outdoor challenges including insect and snake bites and poisonous plants alongside learning skills in hike preparation, map reading, compass use, and identifying animal tracks and wildlife encounters. They will master survival techniques such as splint setting, tourniquet use, hypothermia care, and emergency bandana uses.
